



The Do's and Don't of Training Your Pet for Pet Door Passage

A pet is not acquainted with how the Pet Door Guys weather-tight Endura Flap works. So you will need to train your pet to nudge through the door to the outside and back again.

Since pets love the outdoors, training should be relatively easy. So here are some tips to make training simple for your pet's passage through the pet door.

Do

1. Use praise, and a treat reward for passing through the door.
2. Start with the flap completely open so there is no barrier (you can tape it open).
3. Gradually lower the flap until the pet learns to push against the flap, passing through the opening to get a treat.
4. Take advantage of the edge magnets that can be removed and replaced in stages.
5. Adjust the edge magnet strength to the right resistance for the pet.
6. Make sure you use enough edge magnets to provide a good weather seal.
7. Introduce the security locking cover slowly, so the pet knows the difference and will not run into the cover when it's used.

Don't

1. Do not exceed 10 minutes per training session.
2. Avoid frightening the pet.
3. One frequent way to frighten the pet is to shove it through the opening.
4. Don't make the mistake of ordering the smallest door a pet can just pass through. Instead, provide a little space for ease of passage.
